The **Blake Soccer Academy** (BSA) is a three tiered **Total Player Development** program that starts with individual player training and progresses to premiere team participation. Our player development tiers include:

Tier I, Academy Training- This is open to all players regardless of skill level. The Academy training is designed based on US & UK age group training curriculums. We focus on individual technical skill development with basic tactical understanding.

Tier II, Academy Pride Team Membership- This is the next progression, where players enter into our 360° Training program as members of the Pride teams. The Pride Team members participate in year-long advance academy style training in addition to competitive match play such as winter indoor soccer leagues, futsal, and regional competitive tournaments. The Pride members participate in academy training, team training, invitation scrimmages, league play and tournaments. Pride members are selected during competitive tryouts every June and remain on the team's roster until the following June.

Tier III, Premiere Academy- This is the elite division of BSA, where Pride teams from Tier II have progressed in their team and individual skill level to an elite competition level. This tier is composed of Pride members that have proven success at Tier II (competitive). Once a Pride member or team reach Tier III they will participate in elite and premiere tournament play both in Ohio (i.e. State League and State Cup) and nationally. It typically takes up to one year before a Tier II Pride Team progress to Tier III.



Our 2010 Spring Programs:

BSA Training is designed to provide players/teams with an additional night of training within an environment that will increase specific skill sets over the course of a 90 minute session (60 minutes for under 7 years old). It is also a session when a large group of players come together to create a true Academy environment.

Players will be exposed to specific skill set each training session. In addition, players will get to the experience the positive benefit of being training by different coaches. The aim is to give players different experiences and to get them used to different coaching techniques. Every coach and trainer has a different eye, and a bit of a differing approach – exposing players to multiple coaches and training methods stretches the players and keeps their energy level high.

The ultimate goal is for the Academy as a whole to develop all players regardless of age and ability. Players themselves can help to develop each other with the guidance of the coaching staff. Players will be allowed to concentrate on specific skill sets in each training sessions and will receive follow up guidance (via e-mail) for continuing to work on these skills.

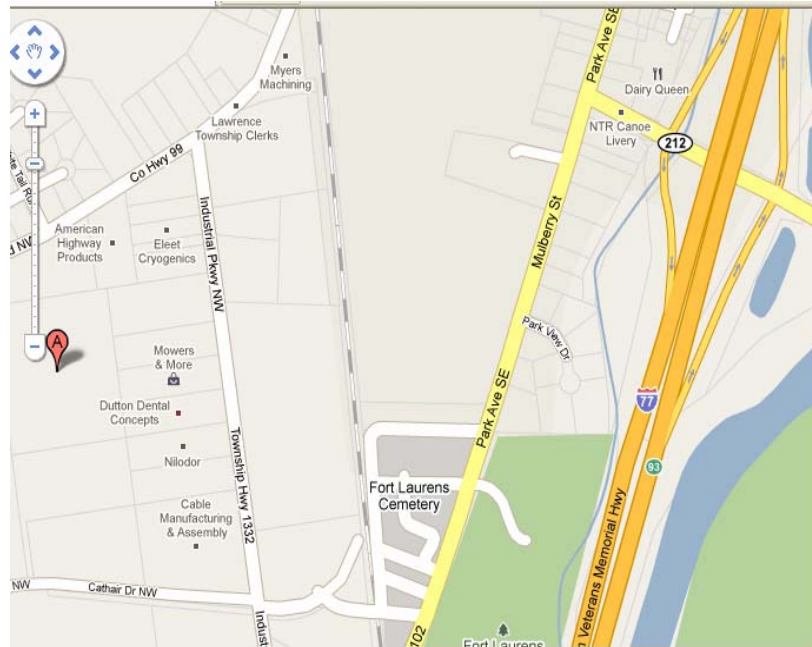
